October 6, 3 pm – The fourth annual Xpect the UnXpected at The Runway by Patrick Restaurant & Bar located at Napa County Airport! The varied and exciting program is full of surprises and lots of fun! The event is a fund raiser for Sing Napa Valley.and features soloists, small ensembles, and surprise guest artists! Beverages from the bar and menu items will be available for purchase before and during the performance. Complimentary desserts from Sweetie Pies will also be served. Seating is limited, so get your tickets early. This joyous holiday performance will be at Napa Methodist Church, 625 Randolph Street, in Napa. The concert will also feature the Napa Valley Children's Chorus conducted by Diane Strohmeyer, and Sing Napa Valley will be joined by soloists tenor Mike Desnoyers, baritone Igor Vieira, and bass William O'Neill. Refreshments will be served at the intermission. Advance tickets are \$25 and are available through December 1. After that, any remaining tickets will be \$30. The public is cordially invited to attend and bring friends and family to this magical celebration of the winter holidays.

**February 23 – 3 pm** – A vivid performance of the music of Broadway promises memories, drama, beautiful singing and even a little dance!
